Title Block Information

Title block information format: All assignments must be identified with the following information written in the title block. Unless otherwise noted, any drawing missing the title block with this information (and the border) will automatically receive a "D" grade, before other criteria are examined:

- Cell 1: Assignment number VERY IMPORTANT and drawing title, abbreviated if necessary
- Cell 2: Your roster number with leading zero if applicable (see roster below), plus your first and last name
- Cell 3: SFSU; course and section number with leading zero, and instructor's last name
- Cell 4: Assignment due date

Also, during the first few weeks, the border can be drawn by hand as demonstrated by the instructor. Later, all borders and title block lines must be drawn with tools: drafting triangles and/ or straight edge, and be the correct dimensions.

Border: 1/2 inch all around the sheet. Title block: 3/4 inch above bottom border. See example below: all in a single line in the drawing, handwritten in neat print.
