DeMarco Murray started the year as the third string running back on the team behind starter Felix Jones and second string running back Tashard Choice. At the end of the 2011 season, Murray led all NFL rookie players (with 40 or more carries) in average per carry (5.5 per carry), yards per game (69.0 yards) and rushing yards (897 yards) on 164 carries (second most among rookie players, Daniel Thomas had 165 carries). On March 9, 2016, Murray was traded from the Eagles to the Tennessee Titans along with the Eagles' 2016 4th round draft pick, in exchange for the Titans' 2016 4th round draft pick. Currently, he ranks second (behind Ezekiel Elliot) among all running backs in the league, with 1,135 yards, 250 carries , and 9 touchdowns.



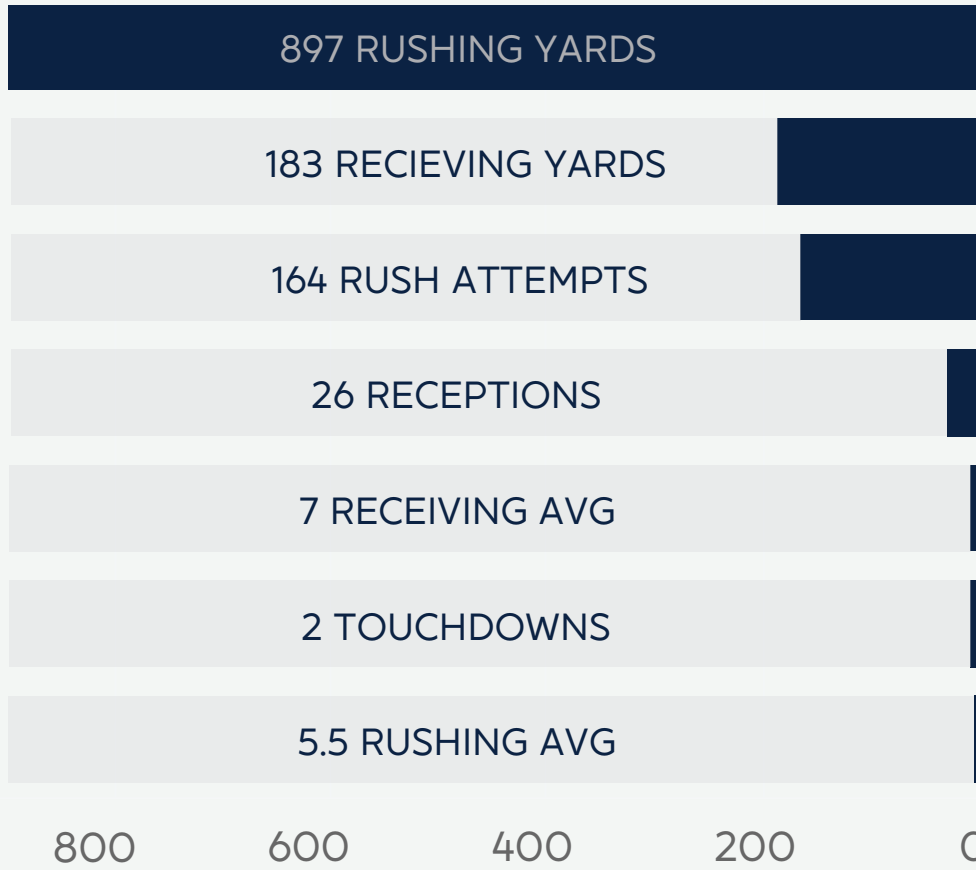

Elliott was selected 4th overall by the Dallas Cowboys in the 2016 NFL draft on April 28, 2016. He is widely regarded as an early favorite for the 2016 Offensive Rookie of the Year while playing behind what many agree upon as the NFL's most dominant offensive line leading up to the 2016 NFL season. On May 18, 2016, Elliott signed his four-year rookie contract reportedly worth \$24.9 million with a \$16.3 million signing bonus. Elliot was named the Dallas Cowboy's start-ing running back going into the regular season, ahead of veterans Alfred Morris and Darren McFadden. After the ninth game of the 2016 season, he became the second Cowboys rookie to rush for more than 1,000 yards in a season, after Tony Dorsett achieved the mark in 1977.

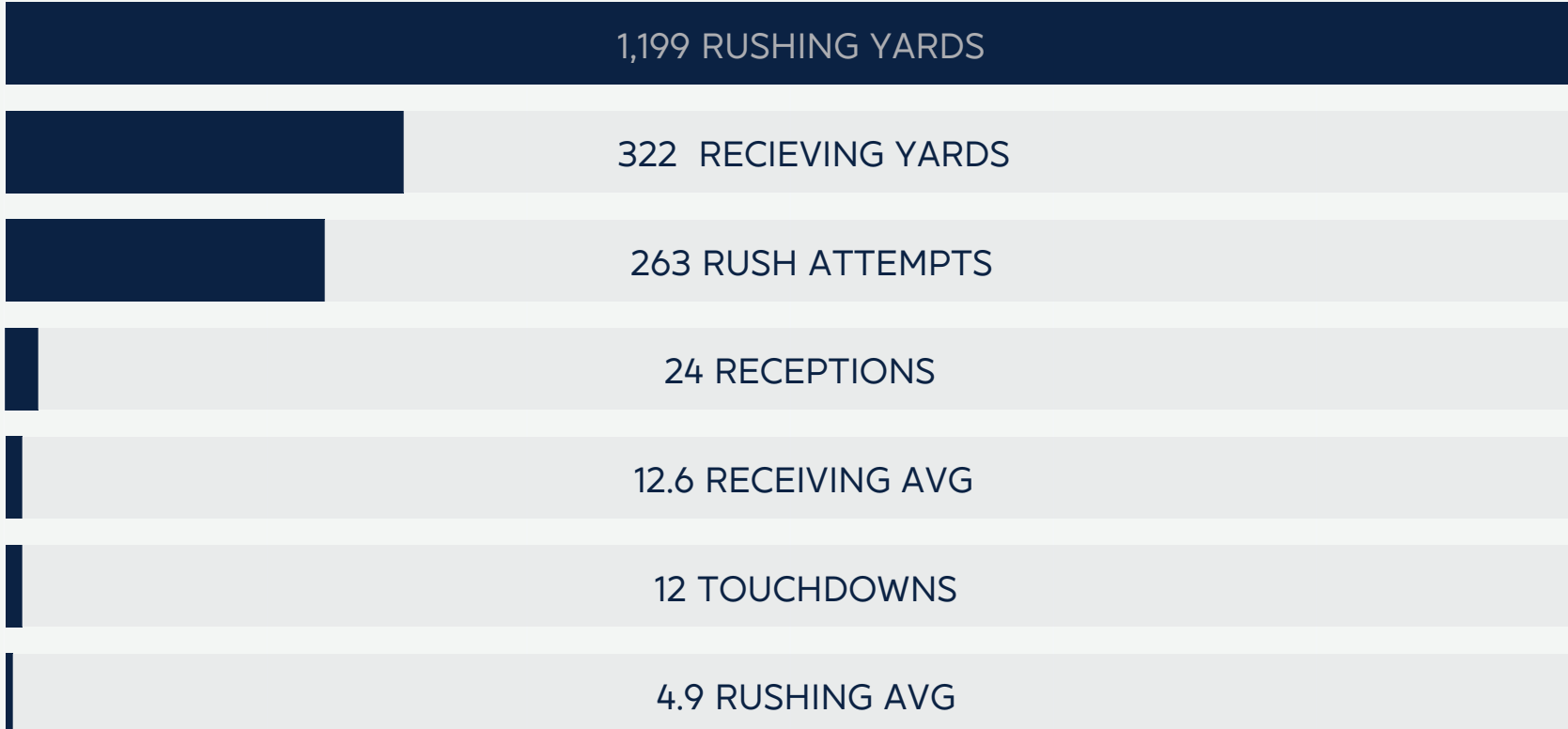

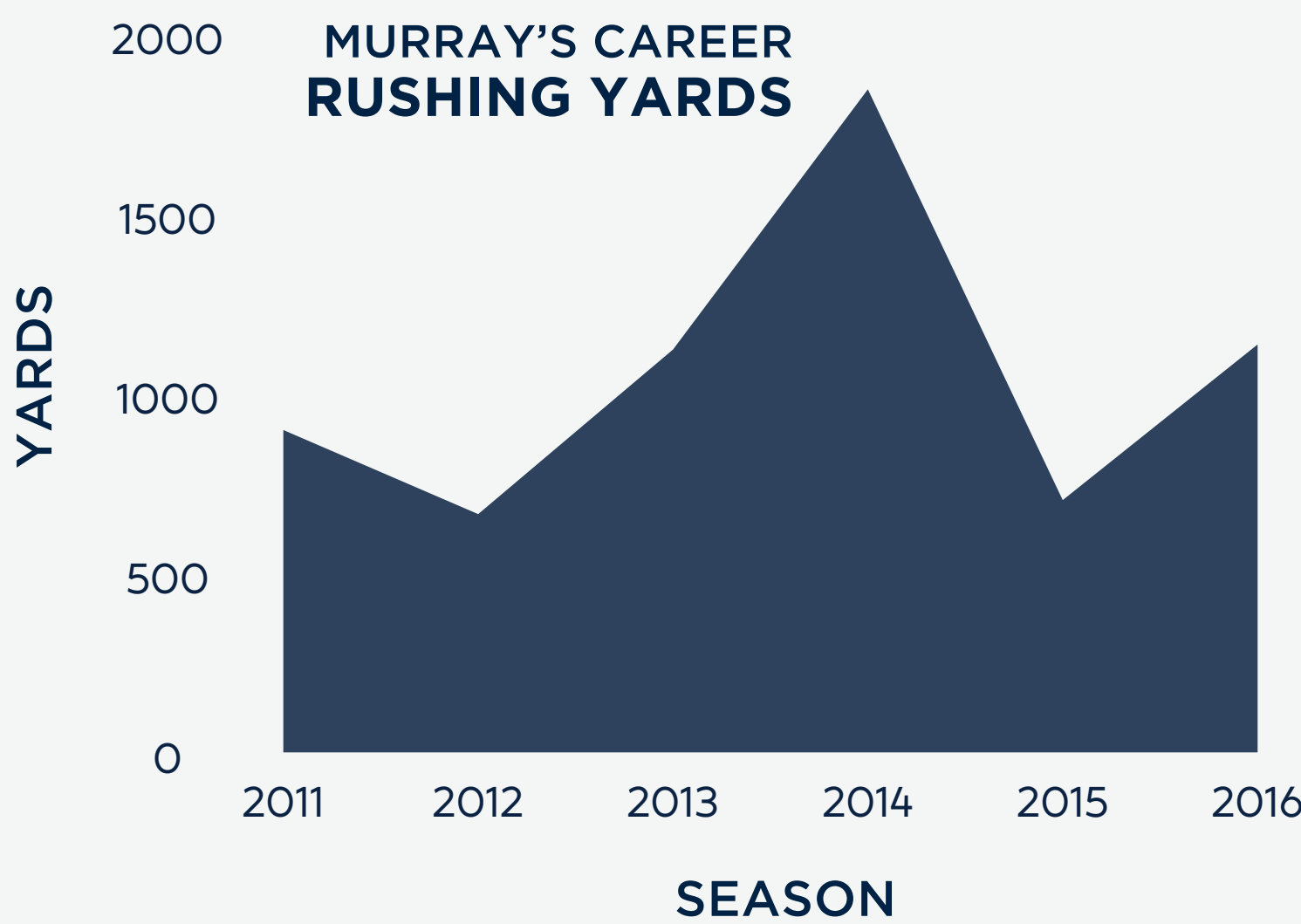
